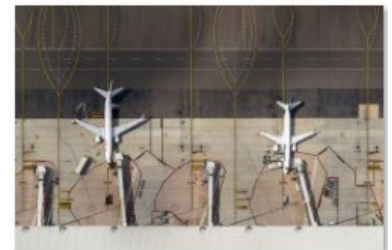


At Adelaide and Parafield Airports we are committed to managing our business operations and activities in an environmentally responsible manner with an emphasis on environment protection and environmental risk management.
