If you're looking for a career in aviation, the Parafield Airport Pilot Scholarship is a fantastic, once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. As part of our commitment to investing in our local area, the scholarship is open to Secondary Students in years 11 and 12 year who attend school within the City of Salisbury, City of Tea Tree Gully or the City of Playford. Upon successful completion of this year long program, the scholarship recipient will be awarded with a Pilot's Licence.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

- 1 **An essay submission will be required upon application, based on the following questions:**
 - Why do you want to become a pilot?
 - What would it mean to you, to be awarded the scholarship?
 - What flying experience do you have, if any?
- 2 **Must attend school within the following Councils:**
 - City of Salisbury
 - City of Tea Tree Gully
 - City of Playford
- 3 **Must be in year 11 or 12 at school within these council areas to apply for the Pilot Scholarship.**
- 4 **Student must commit to attending a minimum two lessons a month with the flight training provider.**
- 5 **The ability to attend bi-monthly progression reviews with responsible adult/s.**
- 6 **Studying and passing one or more of the following subjects is preferred but not mandatory:**
 - Biology
 - Chemistry
 - Physics
 - Maths

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for the Scholarship commence Monday 5th August 2019 and close Friday 16th August 2019 and should contain the following information:

- Cover letter
- Curriculum Vitae
- The essay submission as detailed in point 1
- State your year level and school in which you attend

On the basis of these applications, we will invite selected applicants to attend an interview.

Applicants who are short listed will need to undergo a flight assessment and an aptitude test.

Successful applicants will be awarded the Scholarship pending background and medical checks.

This is a prestigious scholarship and will be awarded to two lucky applicants. When considering applications, we will look for the following characteristics:

- Demonstrated commitment to AAL's vision as set out in the Eligibility Description
- Adequate verbal and written skills to ensure effective communication
- Well-groomed professional appearance and presentation
- Ability to accept responsibility and work under pressure with conflicting deadlines
- Have a "can do" attitude
- Confident in asking questions and seeking clarification
